### Parking and shuttle instruction to all racers and spectators

1. Please obey and respect the parking and shuttling rules of this event. Parking is limited and will be more restricted this year due to over crowding and unsafe conditions last year. The approval of this permit is contingent upon everyone cooperating and following the rules. Racers, please make sure your family and friends know and understand these rules.
2. The first 75 cars WITH 3, (4 or 5 is better) RACERS in their car to arrive at the Visitor Center will be directed to park at the start.
3. 12 milers please plan to be at the shuttle parking lot by 6:30 a.m and 7 milers plan to be there by 7:30 a.m. Do not plan to get on the last bus. If everyone does this then there will be a lot of people who do not make it to the start in time.
4. Family and friends, please wait to load the bus until ALL racers who are present have loaded on the bus. Space is limited on the bus and we need to make sure the racers get to the start so they can check in, get drop bags checked in, go to the bathroom, etc.
5. All spectators need to park at the shuttle parking lot and take the shuttle bus to the start. Absolutely **NO DIRTY 30 PARKING on CRAWFORD GULCH RD.** Shuttle buses will take you where you need to go. Trust me, it is much better this way. This plan avoids people getting ticketed and towed. There is just not enough parking.
6. No dogs allowed at this event, at the Red Barn, at the Start / Finish, on the shuttle bus.

7. No Strollers on the bus. They tear up the seat. Gilpin School has asked that we do not bring strollers on the bus.
8. Shuttle bus will be running all day. In the event of bad weather and racers need to be transported to their cars early, we will have additional buses on stand-by to help get larger crowds back to their cars.
9. No parking or camping at the Start/Finish or Red Barn on Friday night. If you are interested in camping the night before the race please see the website for your camping options. Unfortunately space is very limited around Red Barn.
10. Runners may be dropped off at the Red Barn / Start Area. You will be allowed only a couple minutes to be dropped off. Your driver will then turn around and drive back to the visitor center. They can drive up to the shuttle bus parking lot and take the bus to the start. The park does not want spectators walking along Crawford Gulch Rd. The road is narrow and lacking a shoulder. They have deemed it unsafe.
11. Create a check list. Pack your bag completely with everything you will need for your race and for your post race (change of clothes, jacket, hat, plate, fork knife, money, flip flops, blanket to sit on) before you go to bed. Load your bag in your car. Have it all packed, organized and ready to go. It is likely going to be frantic and lots of pressure to get on the bus when you arrive. We don't want you to forget anything and we don't want you to hold up the bus because you realized you left something in your car that you desperately need. This kind of delay will screw up 50 peoples starting on time. Plan ahead. Be organized when you arrive.
12. There is no cell phone service in most areas in the park and at the start finish area. Please make all aragements before arriving to the race.
